WHAT YOU SHOULD EXPECT WHEN VISITING TASTING ROOMS

We want all wine country guests and winery team members to feel comfortable and safe so everyone can enjoy their experience. We ask that you please take a moment to review a few new guidelines.



TASTING EXPERIENCES ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Guests must have an appointment for all tasting experiences and all experiences are private. Wineries will only accept group sizes of 6 or less, 21 and older. At this time, wineries are not allowing dogs unless they are service animals.



FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL PUBLIC AREAS

Winery team members are required to wear facial coverings at all times. They respectfully request that guests wear facial coverings at all times when not seated at their designated tasting area.



ENHANCED CLEANING MEASURES

Tasting Rooms and Wineries are observing elevated cleaning and sanitation protocols that meet or exceed public health recommendations. Wineries kindly request that guests frequently and thoroughly wash their hands.



SAFETY FIRST, WINE SECOND

It is likely that tasting flights will be prepoured upon arrival to avoid unnecessary close proximity between winery teams and guests. Sanitized glassware will be provided. Single use Tasting Menus (if any) will be provided and water will be available in bottle upon request.



PLEASE AVOID ENTERING IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING KNOWN SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

If you are experiencing any known symptoms of COVID19, we ask that you avoid entering any facilities; we also ask that guests take their temperature before you begin your day in wine country.
